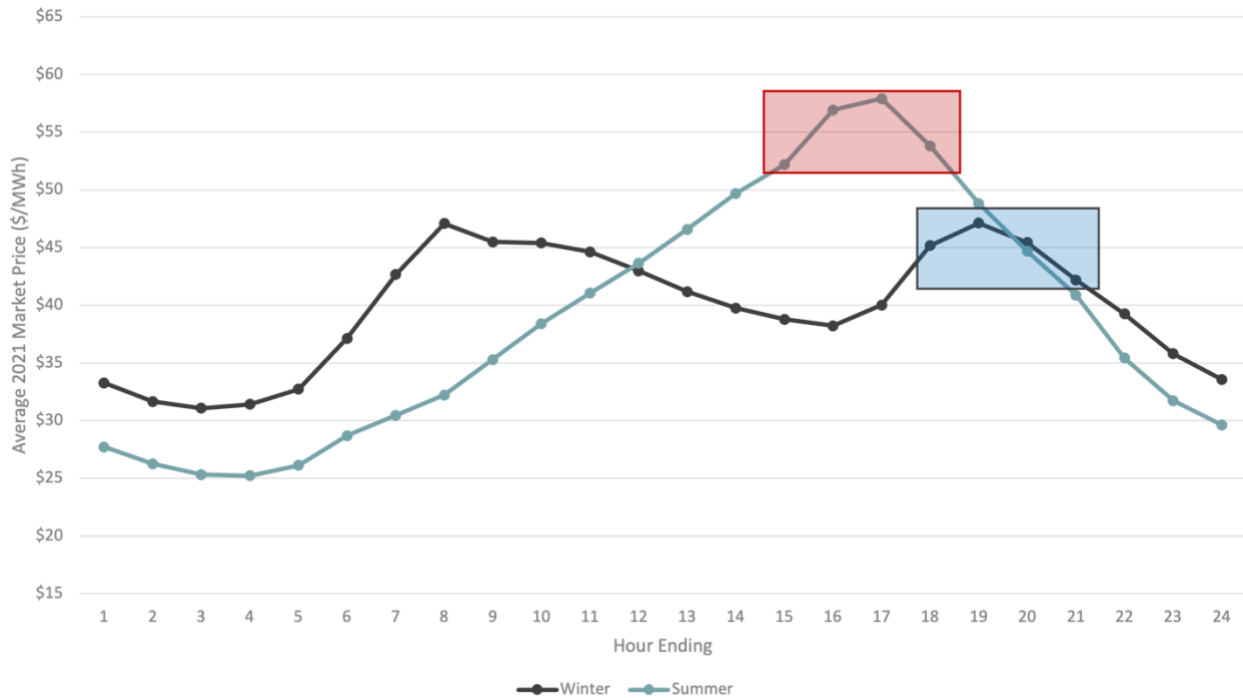


OPTIONAL IRRIGATION TIME-OF-USE

The Irrigation Time-of-Use rate is an optional rate for non-residential members who use significant amounts of energy for things like irrigation, snowmaking, cooling stations, etc. Irrigation Time-of-Use members can expect to see a \$6 increase to the availability charge for single-phase service or a \$7 increase for three-phase service, no change to the on-peak energy rate and a \$0.00100 increase to the off-peak energy rate. The Power Supply Cost Recovery (PSCR) charge will be adjusted as necessary. It is important to note that the PSCR billing mechanism is designed to fluctuate as needed to respond to small changes in power supply costs.

Windows for on-peak usage will remain the same. The summer on-peak window (marked by the red box on the table below) will last from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. from May through September. The winter on-peak window (marked by the blue box on the table below) will last from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. from October to April. Irrigation Time-of-Use members will receive reminders ahead of seasonal peak window shifts.
