

STATE FUNDED ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS



If you're facing an emergency, these funds are set aside to help households at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level who have already received a disconnect notice.

Do I Qualify?

You can qualify for State Emergency Relief funds if:

- If you have an income equal or less than 150% of the federal poverty level and
- You have a past due bill or shut off notice.

*If you don't qualify for SER funds, you might qualify for MEAP funds. Check out the next page to learn more.

Members can apply for State Emergency Relief (SER) funds by calling 1-844-464-3447 or scanning the QR Code.


















STATE FUNDED ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP)-

MEAP is a program designed to help income-eligible households in Michigan make ends meet by providing support for things like electric and gas bills. MEAP funds can be used for home electric and heating needs for members in need. If you've received a disconnect notice, you may qualify for SER funds. Check out the next page to learn more.



Do I Qualify?

You can qualify for MEAP funds if you:

- Know you will not be able to pay your next bill and your household income is below 60% or of the State
 Median Income
- Already participate in:
 - SER State Emergency Relief
 - SNAP Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, otherwise known as the Food Assistance Program
 (FAP) in Michigan
 - TANF Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, otherwise known as the Family Independence
 Program (FIP) in Michigan
 - WIC Woman, Infants & Children
 - Head Start Participation
 - SSI Supplemental Security Income
 - SDA State Disability Assistance
 - HHC Home Heating Credit
